## School and Community

Oswego East High School is an exemplary institution within Community School District 308. The 2,777 students in Grades 9-12 represent communities in the Fox River Valley. District 308 encompasses 60,000 residents. In addition to serving the village of Oswego, School District 308 serves portions of Aurora, Joliet, Minooka, Montgomery, Plainfield and Yorkville, Illinois. School District 308 is the 7th largest school district in the state of Illinois.

Oswego East High School follows an 8 period day. Classes meet for 48 minutes daily, 5 days a week. Students typically take seven classes a day and utilize one period for Lunch/Guided Study. OEHS is fully accredited by the Illinois State

Board of Education. OEHS students earn awards in varied areas including yearbook, newspaper, Pro-Start, Skills USA, National Language exams in German, French and Spanish, Robotics and TARC Rocket teams. OEHS Honor Societies consist of National Honor Society, National Science Honor Society, OEHS Technical Honor Society, National English Honor Society, National Art Honor Society, Mu Alpha Theta, International Thespian Honor Society, National German, Chinese, French and Spanish Honor Society, Rho Kappa History Society, and Tri-M Music Society. Community Service hours are honored. Students tallied 26,000 hours school-wide.

**Faculty:** The OEHS faculty consists of 205 professional staff members. The OEHS pupil-professional ratio is 21 to 1. Oswego East High School ranks in the top 100 high schools in Illinois.
