## **UPDATED Graduation Requirements**

The School District 308 Board of Education has established the following graduation requirements, which comply with and exceed the Illinois State Board of Education Graduation Requirements. College entrance requirements differ greatly and often exceed high school graduation requirements. The table below indicates the School District 308 minimum graduation requirements for the Class of 2026 and beyond.
